Little Grandmother, Kiesha Crowther, spreads her message, very modernly, by free video's on youtube and Vimeo and through doing this she is followed by people from all over the World. A lot of people are deeply touched by her message. Even the ones that are not really into spiritual things can see that the world is not doing well and they understand the importance of her message. In short the message of Little Grandmother says:

We live in a world where we think it's important what other people think of you. We've got to stop this! We spend too much energy in being the way others think we should be. But everybody is unique. You are who you are. Accept each other and respect each other. We should not depend on others to make us feel happy, we are responsible for our own happiness and it should not matter what anybody thinks about you.



We are so used to taking our energy from other people or from –unhealthy- food but there's a much more easy way. Step outside, there's plenty of energy for all of us to recharge outside. Take a deep breath, breathe in the energy of the earth and let the sun shine upon your face. Everything comes from the earth, every bit of food, every drink of water and every breath we take. In exchange for all of this you can give love in return by taking good care of mother earth. You can do this by buying biological products, and to be aware of the garbage you dispose of and the chemicals you wash down the drain.

If you plant a garden, plant it with love. If you buy food in the store then think of it while you cook it or eat it. Cook it with love. We learned how to thank our heavenly father but what about thanking our Mother Earth for the food that is on your plate. She gave it to you.
